Each partner will send 5 learners over 50 years old to learn about the soft-skills in a 5 days training.





- On the second day of the meeting, two experts from Turkish National Agency carried out the on-site monitoring and control activities of the project. They negotiated with the representatives of coordinator institution and partner institutions on the progress of the project.
- At the same time, on the 2nd day of the meeting, interviews and video shootings were made under the leadership of the participants of "Ahi Evran University" with 5 citizens over 65 years, determined by the host institution, as decided at the kick-off meeting. At the end of the project, similar video footage made in all regions where mobility is performed will be a documentary output.



The meeting concluded with the decision of the next meeting program and after the cultural visits in the region.
